OUTDOOR LEARNING ENVIRONMENT - UPDATE

Slide Mountain: I am pleased to let everyone know that the maintenance work on Slide Mountain has now been completed. Once it has been officially approved, the fencing will come down and our children will have access to play in this area again. I would like to thank the ACT Education Directorate for their assistance and support with this project.

Reconciliation Courtyard: Work will begin shortly in this courtyard area to build a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), similar to the one on the blacktop. This will enable us to use this space in all weather and allow our children, P-2, to access this courtyard for learning. We are expecting that this work will be completed within two weeks, opening just in time for spring.

NATIONAL ALEA & AATE CONFERENCE

In the last school holidays, many of our staff attended the 2023 Australian Literacy Educators Association (ALEA) and the Australian Association for the Teaching of English (AATE) National Conference that was held at the ANU. Alys, Hayley and Kelly also presented at this conference, sharing the wonderful practice here at Southern Cross. Alys presented on Interactive Writing and the impact this has on children's writing development and Hayley and Kelly presented how we use the Listening to Reading Protocol to document children's reading behaviours and how we use this information to identify next steps for children's reading development. Both sessions were well received, and we have since been contacted by local Canberra schools to continue to share our great practice.

STAFFING UPDATE

We have been experiencing increased absences from staff as they are impacted by the increasing illness in the Canberra region. Many of our staff are also mothers trying to care for their own children who have also been unwell. Our leadership team are scrambling on most mornings to ensure classes are covered and when this is not possible, classes will be split across their cohort. Unfortunately, there are very few relief teachers left as many have now been given contracts to cover teaching positions in schools in Canberra. Our teachers plan together and have a well-documented program that supports consistency of learning for the children. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and would like to reassure families that our priority is to ensure consistency for learning across learning spaces. We thank you for your ongoing support and kindly ask you to continue keeping your children at home if they are unwell to reduce the illness in our community.
