AFFILIATED SCHOOLS - UNIVERSITY OF CANBERRA PARTNERSHIP

For the last 3 years, our school has partnered with the ACT Education Directorate and the University of Canberra (UC) to engage in a range of initiatives to support early career teachers and professional learning for our staff. One of these initiatives is the PCK Clinics — where pre-service teachers from UC attend a tutorial here at our school. The pre-service teachers work with their tutor in the Community Room and then teach prepared lessons in small groups with our year 1/2 children. The focus this semester is on the science curriculum. The Science PCK Clinic started on Wednesday last week and will continue throughout term 1. I would like to thank our teaching team who were brilliant at supporting the pre-service teachers. We look forward to sharing our knowledge with the pre-service teachers over the coming weeks.

NEWS FROM YEAR 1/2


Year 1/2 have had a very settled start to the year. It has been wonderful to see the children forming new friendships and reconnecting with their old friends.








The children have been engaging in a variety of learning activities and setting up and participating in classroom routines.

EARTH HOUR

WHAT IS EARTH HOUR?

Earth Hour started in Sydney in 2007 and has since grown to become the world's largest movement for the environment, with over 190 countries and territories participating annually to raise awareness!

Earth Hour has grown to become much more than switching your lights off, but that iconic switch-off moment is still an important part of Earth Hour. Millions of participants around the world will switch off their lights at 8:30 pm local time on Saturday 23rd March to demonstrate their support of the environment. This action is symbolic and is not an action to save power. We know it will take so much more than an hour of turning our lights out to have a measurable impact on climate change, but the action helps to bring greater awareness to the issue and demonstrates your commitment to help protect the planet – both during and beyond Earth Hour.

The world's biggest landmarks, like the Empire State Building, London Bridge and Australia's own Sydney Opera House and Harbour Bridge, switch off each year as a symbolic display of their commitment to the planet.

COMING SOON: PARENTAL PORTAL

During term 1 we are rolling out a new Parent Portal, a secure online platform used to share student information between you and your child's teachers.

Using the Parent Portal on your mobile phone, tablet or computer, you will be able to:

- notify us if your child is sick or explain an absence
- book parent-teacher interviews
- receive academic reports
- receive our school newsletter
- receive messages from your child's teachers
- make payments
- access the school calendar and your child's student timetable.

One of the many benefits of the Parent Portal is that it will be used by all ACT public schools from preschool through to year 12, so there will be no need to use a different system as children change schools during their public-school journey. If you have children at nearby schools you will not need to sign up to the system twice. You will be able to easily add a student to your account once their school has access to the Parent Portal.

SIGN UP NOW

To access the portal, you will need to create or have access to an ACT Government Digital Account. You can sign up now and complete the level 2 identity verification process to get ready for our launch this term.

To complete the identity verification process, you will need one of the following:

- Driver's licence
- Australian Passport
- Birth certificate
- Australian citizenship certificate
- Change of name certificate
- Marriage certificate
- ImmiCard
- Australian visa
- Medicare
- Centrelink Concession Card

If you have any issues with creating your account and completing your level 2 identity verification you can get in contact with ACT Digital Account to resolve by calling 13 22 81.
