#### **SEESAW**

Seesaw is an app and a way for our teachers and families to communicate quickly and easily. Teachers will post information about the learning that is happening in the classrooms, families can message teachers privately and messages/reminders will be posted as well. Teachers will be posting to Seesaw this week to activate your child's 2024 class journal, please look out for Seesaw notifications. New children to Southern Cross will receive a QR code from their class teacher once all permission forms have been returned to the front office.

#### **RAINY DAYS**

I would like to encourage all families to help their child pack gumboots, a raincoat, an umbrella (optional) and **a spare change of clothes** on rainy days (P-2). The children can play outside or have the choice to play under the COLA (K-2). This allows everyone to get some fresh air between learning sessions and will help us all to stay healthy. Unfortunately, we do not have enough spare clothing for the whole school so children can only play outside in the rain if they have spare clothing to change into after their play. #### BASE ASSESSMENTS IN KINDERGARTEN

Each year in weeks 3 and 4 of term 1 and weeks 2 and 3 of term 4, our kindergarten children are engaged in BASE assessments with their teacher. The purpose of the assessment is to measure learning growth in reading and mathematics throughout the kindergarten year. The children will each spend time one on one with their teacher to support the engagement in this assessment. Kindergarten families will be provided with further information this week. #### **IMPORTANT HOUSEKEEPING**

**Contact Details:** It is **vital** to have up to date contact information for each family with children enrolled at Southern Cross Early Childhood School.

If you have changed your address or updated your phone number please email <u>nicole.emerton@ed.act.edu.au</u> to ensure we have the current information.

Medical Information: Families are required to complete a new Medical Information and Consent Form each year.

These have been emailed to families last week.

Children with a **Known Medical Condition** are required to provide a current Medical Action Plan, completed by a medical professional, to the school on a yearly basis.

#### **ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS**

If your child is away from school, you will receive an SMS to let you know your child has been recorded as absent. We will endeavour to send this message by 10.30am every day. This will reassure you of your child's arrival at school and make it easier for you to keep your child's attendance record up to date when they are absent.

Simply reply via SMS, with your child's name and the reason for your child's absence, your reply will be saved directly onto your child's attendance record. If you do not reply, your child's absence will be recorded as 'unexplained'.

- For unexpected absences, responding to the SMS will notify the school and be placed directly onto your child's attendance record.
- For late arrival, you may still receive an SMS in the morning, please sign in at reception and your child's attendance record will be updated to a partial attendance for that day.
- For planned absences, we would still appreciate advanced notice of your child's absence.

#### COMMUNICATION

We have many different ways of communicating information with you all. We are hopeful that one of these communication methods works for each family in our school so that all of you have access to the information you need.

**Newsletters:** The school newsletter is emailed to families each Monday of even weeks (week 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10).

**Facebook:** We share learning and special events via Facebook. Our school P&C also have their own Facebook page where they share events and information.

**Seesaw:** Class teachers and leaders will post messages, learning and updates through Seesaw. Your child's teacher will advise once they start using Seesaw.

**Email:** If you wish to contact your child's teacher directly, you are welcome to send an email or call Nicole at reception who can support you to make contact with the teacher.

**Morning Muster:** Each morning our teachers will be out in the outdoor learning environment at 8:55am. This is an opportunity for any quick messages you might have for the teacher that will support your child's day.

  of the nomination and election process.
