2023 SCHOOL SATISFACTION & CLIMATE SURVEY

An email about the parent survey, including a unique link to access the survey. Genuine survey invitation emails will have the title "The 2023 School Satisfaction & Climate Survey is now open!" and will be sent from EDU Surveys & Evaluation with 'from' address EDU@gualtrics-survey.com.

If you do not receive the survey invitation, please check your Junk email folder; if it is not there, please contact your school.

The Parents and Carers Survey will be available online in other languages: Arabic, Burmese, Chinese, Hindi, Korean, Urdu, Vietnamese, Punjabi, Bengali, Spanish, Telugu, French and Italian. Respondents can select their preferred language when they start the survey.

For the results to reflect the opinions of our whole school community, we need as many parents and carers, staff and students as possible to complete the survey. Your feedback is important, and we hope you will take part.

SCIENCE WEEK AT SOUTHERN CROSS

This year's theme for Science Week is **INNOVATION: POWERING FUTURE INDUSTRIES.** We celebrated this at Southern Cross School by having a Science Day! It was a day filled with six main activities that children could chose as their interests dictated, where they had a chance to be creative thinkers and solve problems. The activities were:

Binary Code Bracelet- Where children could learn what binary code is and make a beaded bracelet that spells out their name in binary code.

Solve a problem- Where children could design and build a trap to attract and capture insects that were eating vegetable crops.

Improve a design- Make a paper plane using a straw for a fuselage and then make it fly even better.

Change it up- Modify or repurpose something to try and create something new from something old.

First Nations Scientists- Using things found in nature, what things can you create?

Make it stronger- What materials can you use to build a bridge as strong as possible?





Change it up – Repurposing, recycling, renewing, recreating and rebuilding.







Make it stronger – Fortification, strengthening and reinforcing.



The children were also encouraged to think of inventions that could solve a problem. I hope you enjoy these sample of photographs showcasing our science day.

TERM 3 IN KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten has had a busy start to our term 3 learning. The children have been focusing on their own personal reading and writing strategies and developing their number skills, exploring place value, skip counting and teen numbers.

100 DAYS OF SCHOOL

In week 2 we celebrated our 100 days of school! To mark this occasion the children dressed up as someone who looks 100 years old or dressed up with 100 items on their clothing. Throughout the day we participated in a variety of activities based on the number 100! We had a great time celebrating this milestone.







WILD WEDNESDAY

Our Play Workshop this term has been centred around the children being Explorers of the World. Each Wednesday kindergarten gathers their equipment which includes a diary, pencil, explorer bag, collection bag and magnifying glass and we explore areas outside of the school. The children are encouraged to collect and observe items of interest which they can then investigate further. We are exploring mapping techniques and the use of directional language.









SCIENCE WEEK

Last week we celebrated Science Week, the theme was 'Innovation'. The children participated in a range of science activities set up and run by the teachers and educators. On Wednesday afternoon the children were able to visit various stations and participate in a range of experiments.







HOCKEY


