Contact Details: It is **vital** to have up to date contact information for each family with children enrolled at Southern Cross Early Childhood School.

Medical Information: Families are required to complete a new **Medical Information and Consent Form** each year. These will be emailed to families in Term 1, 2024.

Children with a **Known Medical Condition** are required to provide a current Medical Action Plan, completed by a medical professional, to the school on a yearly basis. Families with children in preschool will also work with class teachers to develop a risk minimisation plan.

MUSIC AT SOUTHERN CROSS

In music, children have been continuing to experiment with a range of instruments, compose their own music and perform to their peers. It has been so wonderful to see the kindergarten and year 1/2 children so excited to perform their compositions! Children had the option to work by themselves or in a small group where they had to carefully plan their roles, decide their instruments, as well as include elements of music (dynamics, tempo, rhythm, structure and pitch). Well done kindergarten and year 1/2!

We have also been focusing on rhythm notation where children use their knowledge of syllables to determine rhythms to clap, as well as working as a class to play songs on the boom whackers. RENT RELIEF IN THE ACT

The Christmas/Festive season is fast approaching, and along with it is the additional Christmas/Festive preparation expenses, not to mention the bills that will start rolling in come the New Year!

Care continues to facilitate the ACT Government's Rent Relief program for those who rent privately in the ACT. Eligible renters can apply for the one off grant of 4 weeks rent up to a maximum of \$2,500.



0-4Weeks

- making new sounds

- listening to simple stories and songs
- climbing, dressing up and playing make believe

3 Years



- speaking simple sentences
- understanding most of what you say
- asking lots of questions
- drawing, joining the dots
- running and learning to climb stairs

4 Years



- counting 10 or more objects
- + playing with other children
- starting to tell the difference between real and pretend
- wanting to do more things by myself
